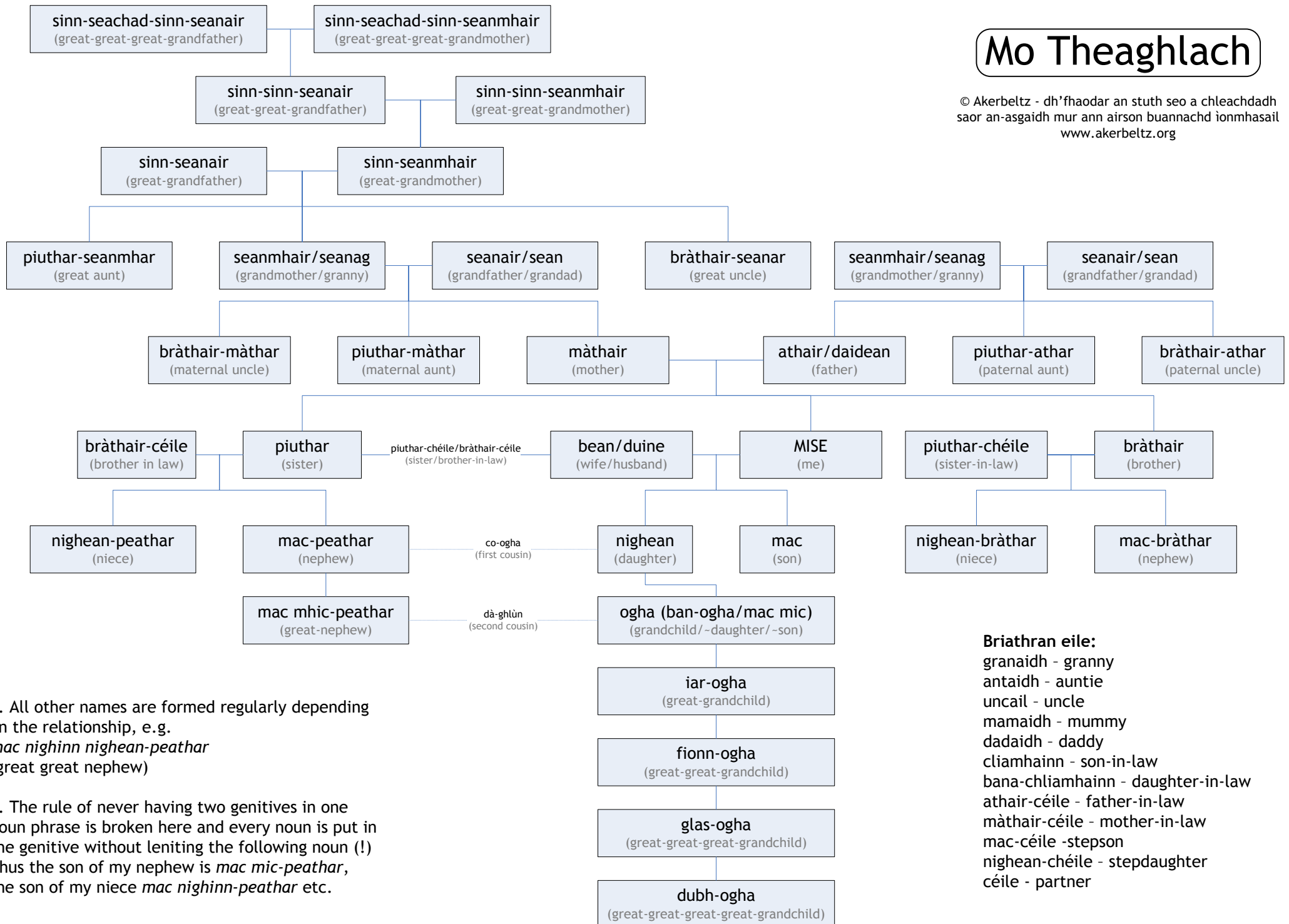


# Mo Theaghlach

1. All other names are formed regularly depending on the relationship, e.g.  
*mac nighinn nighean-peathar*  
(great great nephew)

2. The rule of never having two genitives in one noun phrase is broken here and every noun is put in the genitive without leniting the following noun (!)  
Thus the son of my nephew is *mac mic-peathar*,  
the son of my niece *mac nighinn-peathar* etc.
